5. Your plans for next year and beyond

ATTACH THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS TO THIS APPLICATION FORM ELECTRONICALLY:

A) An official , up to date transcript from your high school AND your second semester Mid Term Report card OR a Credit Counseling Summary with mid-term marks in courses not yet completed; if this is not available when the application is sent in, you must bring a copy with you to your interview.

B) A resume* that includes:

- your theatre experience and training in and out of school
- co-curricular activities besides theatre in school
- volunteer work in your community
- employment history

**Please start with the most recent and go back; pre high school information is not required.*

C) Sponsor's Recommendation: this must be an arts teacher at your school *

Please attach, on school letterhead, a brief description of the applicant's strengths and needs, including your evaluation of his or her potential for success in post secondary arts training and the performing arts/arts education.

**additional non-school reference letters are welcome but not required.*

D) Write a paragraph outlining the post secondary programs you are interested in, where you have applied and where you have been accepted, and which program you have chosen, if known at time of application.

F) Write a short essay (300-400 words) explaining why the arts are important and how you see yourself contributing to an artistic community.

You may wish to bring a portfolio or album containing designs, programs, photographs, reviews or other evidence of your achievements with you to your interview. **Do not bring CD/DVDs.**
